

EXECAIR OPENS EXECUTIVE AIRCRAFT HANDLING CENTRE IN PRAGUE

Execair, the executive aircraft handling business of Menzies Aviation Group, has opened its tenth European station at Prague's Ruzyně Airport.

This latest expansion comes just two weeks after MAG announced the acquisition of Parc Aviation Handling in Dublin. Execair now operates in Aberdeen, Birmingham, Brussels, Cardiff, Charleroi, Dublin, East Midlands, Edinburgh, Inverness and Prague.

Alex MacDonald, Execair's Operations Director, said: "Opening in Prague is another important step in our ambition to build an extensive European network. I am delighted with this new facility. The standard of accommodation is excellent and will add further to Execair's high quality reputation."

Sonny Sonnberger, Managing Director of Menzies Aviation Group in the Czech Republic, who will manage the new Prague handling operation, added: "Execair is a valuable addition to our existing ground handling activity here in Prague. We now have the capability to handle all types of aircraft in dedicated commercial or private executive facilities."

Menzies Aviation Group acquired Execair in 1999 as a business then operating at four UK airports. Expanding to 10 airports demonstrates MAG's long-term commitment to grow its network for handling executive aircraft and associated services.
